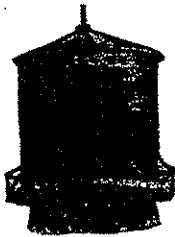

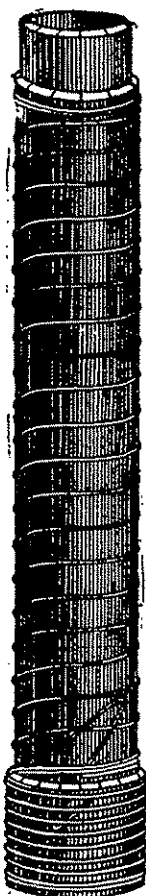

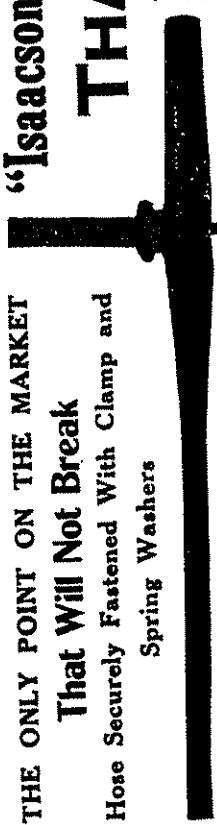

IDITAROD—Iditarod City, situated on the Iditarod River, 300 miles above the junction of the Innoko and Yukon, the metropolis of Alaska's newest placer country, is a city of 300 inhabitants, and was founded on the first of June, 1910, with the arrival of the first stamperders from Fairbanks.

The camp was discovered on Christmas day, 1908, when William A. Dikeman and John Beaton struck pay on Discovery claim, Otter Creek. The succeeding summer saw a considerable stampede, but the winter of 1909 was a quiet one, owing to the long delayed discovery of the rich pay of Flat Creek. In July, 1910, the first real discovery of rich ground was made on the Marietta claim near the head of Flat, and it was but a short time thereafter till the world knew that a new placer camp had been added to the resources of Alaska.

The pay creeks are Otter, 40 miles long and a tributary of the Iditarod River, coming in 260 miles above the mouth and 16 miles above Iditarod City; Granite, Black and Flat are tributaries of Otter, Flat Creek being the richest creek in the district and carrying a wide paystreak from the

extreme head to the mouth, a distance of four and a half miles; Willow Creek, 10 miles long, is also a tributary of the Iditarod, paralleling Otter and coming in above; Happy, a tributary of Willow, heads near the head of Flat and carries good pay. Willow has a wide extent of low grade dirt and will prove a fine dredging proposition.

Flat City is situated on Otter at the mouth of Flat and is a thriving town nearly as large as Iditarod City. Discovery is also the name of a busy town. Otter City is situated at the mouth of Otter on the Iditarod, but its one-time glory has departed. Many vacant cabins mark the spot where a big town was promised, but a little scow freighting in the spring to Flat gives it only a passing stir of activity.

Iditarod City is well laid out in blocks and streets, and is but seven miles overland from Flat. The city has a bank, a hospital and a complete telephone system, which takes in all the creeks, and has recently acquired a wireless plant with telegraphic communication with Gibbon and St. Michael.

The city has a mayor and six councilmen, fire department equipped to maintain a standing water pressure, and an efficient police department.

Besides numerous mercantile houses of all descriptions, the town has two saw-mills, a weekly newspaper, machine shops, a cold storage plant and a bottling plant. A tramway is in operation to Flat City.

In the high water period of spring big steamers can come to Iditarod City and even to the mouth of Otter. Later in the season, however, Dikeman becomes the head of navigation and freight is transshipped by small steam craft and gasoline boats.

Otter precinct is the official name of the Iditarod district with a
