Contains a Greek church and salmon canneries. Karluk is in the center of the mining operations on Kadiak Island, it is principally placer and beach mining. It is the most famous red salmon fishing place in the world and the greatest record of catching salmon in the world has been made here. It is a landing place for steamers plying between Seattle, Kodiak, Valdez, Sitka and Juneau once a month. Uyak, 18 miles e, is the nearest p o.

Salmon fishing and canning is the principal industry. Has a Catholic church and three general stores. Semi-monthly mail steamers from Hope, Seldovia, Homer and other coast points.

KETCHIKAN

Pop 1,613 (U S Census, 1910). A city incorporated in 1900 and first settled in 1889, located on Tongass Narrows, Revillagigedo Island, 662 miles n of Seattle, 237 se of Juneau and 60 n of the southern boundary line of Alaska. It is the first port of entry and last port of departure for all vessels engaged in commerce in Southeastern Alaska, and the commercial distributing point for the southern 140 miles of Alaska tributary to which are two large smelters, several stamp mills, salmon canneries, a number of saw mills, with various other industries as well as extensive mining operations. It sustains a daily and weekly newspaper, The Miner, an electric light plant, water system, volunteer fire department, public school, Methodist, Catholic and Episcopal churches, a U S customs house,

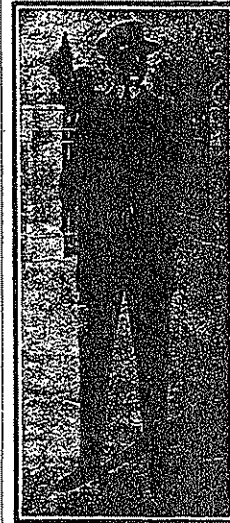

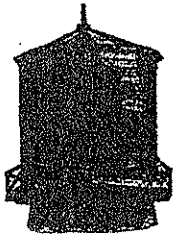
